OUR PROJECTS

Mt Druitt PCYC - First Nations Lead

Barra-gi Consulting are the First Nations Lead for the architectural design for Mt Druitt PCYC, working alongside AJC Architects. We are actively engaging and leading the design workshops to ensure cultural knowledge, understanding and development of design principles through the Walk on Country and First Nations engagement plan are positively embedded into design outcomes. We are continually developing strong relationships with the Dharug Led Design Panel to ensure their voices are heard and ensuring we are creating opportunities for their guidance to be embedded into the design.

UNSW - First Nations Lead

Barra-gi Consulting have been engaged by AJC Architects as the First Nations Lead to create strong opportunities to embed a strong sense of Country, culture and knowledge into design outcomes. We are working alongside Bidjigal and Gadigal First Nations community members and project partners to create opportunities of learning, sharing and inclusion. We are assisting the project team to positively understand how wayfinding, art and education can be culturally integrated with the assistance of local businesses, Knowledge Holders and artists through positive co-design opportunities. Through an organised Walk on Country community had the opportunity to discuss materials, spacial requirements, cultural integration how the landscape can create connecting spaces throughout the campus.



OUR PROJECTS

Berrys Bay - First Nations Engagement

We have been engaged by Design Inc - Sydney to undertake engagement with First Nations community members to follow up on previous work completed through a Connecting with Country process for this site. Our ability to connect community members and the project team has allowed for community to elevate their voices and influence design outcomes through collaboration and creating a sense of inclusivity.

Green Loop Design Guide - First Nations Engagement

Barra-gi Consulting have a strong working partnership with COLA Studios and were engaged to undertake First Nations engagement with the Dharug community to identify design opportunities and outcomes for the Green Loop which is located in Bradfield City, NSW. Community members discussed colour palettes, signage, wayfinding and opportunities for sharing knowledge, culture and history. Community members were invited and encouraged to participate as we provided a culturally safe space for voices to be heard.

Kellyville & Bella Vista Precinct - Designing with Country

Barra-gi Consulting were engaged by COLA Studios to undertake First Nations engagement as part of the Connecting with Country process. We created a culturally safe space to assist in understanding Country and how design outcomes can benefit from the First Nations community members who attended the Walk on Country, workshops and one-on-one consultations.

Rosebery Seniors Living - First Nations Engagement Specialist

Barra-gi Consulting were engaged by Djinjama as First Nations engagement specialists to undertake First Nations engagement, we conducted one-on-ones to ensure we were able to hear Elders, Knowldge Holders and locally connected community members to hear stories, wayfinding opportunities and how First Nations engagement can influence design outcomes.
